1. 1. Muslims should avoid shirk (associating partners with Allah) because it is a great sin.
2. Muslims should observe good behavior, such as humility, patience, and advising others to do good and avoid evil.
2. 1. Those who believe (have faith)
2. Those who do good deeds
3. Those who encourage each other to truth and patience
3. You can ask Rajab to read **Surah Al-Humazah**, which warns against piling up wealth and neglecting others.
4. The Surah that says mountains will be like carded wool is **Surah Al-Qari'ah**.
5. 1. To meditate and reflect on the problems and wrongdoings in society, seeking closeness to Allah.
2. To worship Allah in solitude away from the idol worship and corruption of the Quraysh people.
6. 1. Acts of worship and relationship with Allah.
2. Moral and ethical behavior towards others.
3. Social, economic, and legal matters in daily life.
7. 1. **Hadith** refers to the recorded sayings, actions, and approvals of the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH).
2. **Sunnah** refers to the way of life or practices of the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH), which Muslims are encouraged to follow.
8. 1. Hadith explains and clarifies the teachings of the Qur'an, helping Muslims understand how to practice Islam correctly.
2. Hadith provides guidance on moral conduct, worship, and daily life, serving as a source of Islamic law and ethics.
9. 1. Tawrah (Torah) — revealed to Prophet Musa (Moses)
2. Zabur (Psalms) — revealed to Prophet Dawud (David)
3. Injil (Gospel) — revealed to Prophet Isa (Jesus)
4. Qur'an — revealed to Prophet Muhammad (PBUH)
10. 1. Choose friends who have good behavior, are respectful, and encourage you to do the right things.
2. Avoid friends who engage in bad habits or influence you to disobey school rules and your faith.
11. 1. **The Qur'an** — the holy book of Allah.
2. **The Sunnah** — the practices and teachings of Prophet Muhammad (PBUH).
12. 1. Tawheed strengthens a Muslim's faith by teaching them to worship Allah alone and rely only on Him. 2. It promotes humility and obedience, as the Muslim recognizes Allah as the only Creator and Sustainer of everything.
13. The prophet of Allah who constructed an ark was **Prophet Nuh (Noah)**.
14. 1. Shirk in Rububiyyah — associating partners with Allah in His Lordship (believing others share in His power of creation, control, or provision).

2. Shirk in Uluhiyyah — directing acts of worship to other than Allah (praying to idols, humans, or anything else).
3. Shirk in Asma wa Sifat — giving Allah's names or attributes to others, or attributing human qualities to Allah.

 1. Swalatul Janaza has no rukuu (bowing) or sujood (prostration) — it is performed standing only.
 2. It consists of four takbirs (saying Allahu Akbar) with specific supplications for the deceased.
17. The term '**Qasr**' in relation to *Swalatul Musafir* means **shortening the four-unit (rak'ah) prayers to two units** when a Muslim is traveling.

 1. Sunnah Swalat brings Sadiq closer to Allah and earns him additional rewards.
 2. It helps to make up for any shortcomings or mistakes in his obligatory (fardh) prayers.
