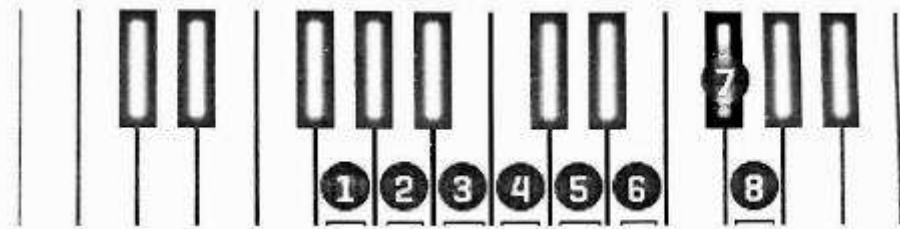

4. - They drew some shapes in front of others to make them appear closer and more important.
 - They made the overlapping shapes larger or darker to create emphasis and dominance.
5. still life drawing.
6. Monotone — the use of a single colour or tone throughout a design to create a rhythmic pattern.
7. - It is made by combining cut-out pictures or images from different sources into one composition.
 - It creates a single artwork that conveys a specific theme or message.
8. - Both promote teamwork and cooperation.
 - Both develop creativity and self-expression.
 - Both improve physical and mental well-being.

- An **answer phrase** follows the question phrase and ends conclusively, giving a sense of completion or resolution.

12. - Camera or smartphone (to take photos)
- Printing paper or photo paper (to print the photos)
- Glue or adhesive (to stick the photos)
- A large manila paper, cardboard, or board (to arrange and display the photos)
13. - Blowing gently to produce a clear tone (breath control)
- Tonguing to separate notes cleanly
- Covering the finger holes properly to get correct pitches
- Maintaining correct posture and hand position while playing

15. - Ensure the playing surface is clean, dry, and free of obstacles.
- Wear appropriate sports shoes and clothing to avoid injuries.
- Keep a safe distance from the net and other players to prevent collisions.
16. - Hold the recorder correctly with the left hand on top.
- Cover the back thumb hole completely with the left thumb.
- Cover the top three front holes (1, 2, and 3) with the left index, middle, and ring fingers.

– Blow gently into the mouthpiece while keeping the holes tightly sealed to produce the note **G**.
